MASH run a Drop-In in Manchester city centre where women who are street sex working can access practical help and support.

The Drop-In is a warm and welcoming place where women receive support from experienced Case Workers with issues such as: dealing with addiction, finding somewhere to live, reporting violence, safety, dealing with debts or mental health problems. We also run sessions to empower women and build their self-confidence. Art therapy is part of this process.

The art work in the exhibition has been produced by women at the MASH Drop-In Centre; there are various themes such as 'colour' and 'women'. The art work is going to be exhibited over a week with an opportunity for the public and MASH supporters to visit on the evening of Tuesday 24th.
